RAGIMANUPENTA CHURCH

Birth of the Bangarupalayam Project

A spiritual revival was going on during the late seventies in Andhra Pradesh villages. Several people responded to the gospel of the Lord Jesus and new congregations were started

in these villages. Rev. J.J. Pratt, who served as a missionary in the Telugu region before his ministry in St. John's Vellore, had an interest and wanted to nurture and support these new Christians. In February 1981, a



team from St. John's Church visited to assess the needs of the new Christians. In essence, the St. John's Church desired to help poor Christian Communities to put up church buildings for worship services and other meetings. The Church General Body meeting held in October 1981 resolved to give aid to new congregations to build Churches. Thadakara, Indranagar, Ragimanupenta, Guntlakattamanchi, Maradipalli and Diguamatyam were included in the project. Dr. Paul Vaska, Dr. Samuel Chittaranjan, Prof. Azariah, Prof. K. Barnabas, Dr. Anand Job and Mr. Sam Christopher carried out evangelistic work through preaching, film shows and medical camps. The Evangelistic Committee held on 29th March 2021, resolved to equip the Churches in outreach areas to mark the significance of our Church's 175th Year Celebration. Except for Ragimanupenta, other villages under the Bangarupalayam project built new churches. Since the members are very poor in Ragimanupenta, they are unable to build another church for their congregation.

Ragimanupenta Church: This church was started with ten families of new Christians in 1981. Now the congregation has 80 families. Mr. Chandrasekar, employed by our church, is working as Evangelist for Ragimanupenta and Indiranagar.

They are worshipping in the church that was built by St. John's in 1994. This place was donated by one of the church members, Mr. Rathinavelu. The present church is too small for its members.



Our Evangelistic team visited Ragimanupenta village on Sunday the 2nd of October 2022. Dr. Jeevaratnam, Dr. Titus and Mr. Sam Jebadurai (CMC Chittoor) led the Praise and Worship in Telugu. Dr. Lionel in his greetings, shared a brief thought on Matthew 7:24-28 about the Wise and Foolish builders. Rev. Rajesh shared God's Word on the Redemption of God, from the lives of Zacchaeus (Luke 19: 1-10) the tax collector and Nicodemus (St John 3:1-16), a ruler of the Jews. Mr. Joseph Sampathkumar, Mr. Sam Christopher and Dr. Tilak Francis participated in the trip. We distributed 55 Bibles in Telugu and handed over Sunday school materials.

The members of the Ragimanupenta church shared with us their need to build a new church to accommodate more numbers. Mr. Yesuratnam, the son of Mr. Rathinavelu who donated land for the present church, has generously given a large piece of land behind the existing structure for the new church. We visited the proposed site and offered a prayer for the blessings of the Lord Jesus on this project. After completing the registration of the land on CSITA - Synod and working out the blueprint, they laid the foundation for the new church building



on 28th July 2024. Since the AGM of the church was held on that day, we could not participate in this important event. As reported in the AGM on 10th August, our Pastor and Evangelistic Committee

convener visited Ragimanupenta to honour their invitation. The St. John's Church Evangelical team of yesteryears envisioned building a church for this handful of believers in that remote region; this has blossomed into a bigge



region; this has blossomed into a bigger congregation. Praise God for the wonderful work through St. John's Church members led by Rev. J.J. Pratt to reach out to these villages.

Sunday School Retreat

The St. John's Sunday school enjoyed a picnic to Pravaham, Palamathy on Sunday, 15th September 2024.

Mohan and Jannice were our resource persons for the day and they took lot of effort to ensure that the children never experienced a dull moment. They were divided into a junior and a senior group. The junior group met after a morning snack in their classes - Volunteers from the team engaged them in activities and teaching that kept them engaged and challenged till the lunch break. The theme was about being like Daniel and the teachers were able to discuss Daniel's various attributes with their students through activities. After a scrumptious lunch, toddlers to grade 5 left for their respective homes.

There was a session from 12:45 p.m. to 1:30 p.m. taken by Mohan exclusively for the parents. He skipped his lunch break to take it as he was very keen to engage the parents with a challenge to intentional parenting. He used Daniel as an example of a young man – away from his family making firm decisions and challenged parents to raise such children with a firm Christian footing.

The senior classes from 6th grade to the Senior class undoubtedly had the most fun at the picnic. The whole day was

broken into small sessions and challenges for them. The various attributes of Daniel-like perseverance, faith, trust, taking a stand, respect, reliability were discussed with various activities like archery, tight rope walking, a paint the flag session and the most enjoyed "prusiking" - or climbing a vertical using mountaineering rope techniques.

We have a QR code which can be used to donate money to the church. These must be accompanied by specific instructions as to which fund the money should go to.

The various funds are as listed below:

Monthly Subscription and Thank Offering:

60% of the Free will offering (Offertory), the Monthly Subscription and Thank offering made via the designated cover are sent to the Diocese as our assessment contribution.

Those who are members of St. John's Church need to make sure they send a monthly subscription of at least Rs.50

<u>Helping hands:</u> This fund caters to a large number of outreach projects such as Shanthigramam, Karunai Illam, Anbu Illam, etc

<u>Building and Maintenance:</u> Contributions to this fund go towards the maintenance of the church and its premises.

Evangelistic work: Various mission fields and evangelists are supported from this fund.

<u>Scholarship fund</u>: This fund is used to provide scholarships to deserving children for higher studies.

<u>Sunday School</u>: Funds are used for the activities of the Sunday school and for any project or area of need that the Sunday school decides to support.

<u>Youth activities</u>: This fund is used for activities of the youth in our church. They also contribute to special activities such as Hope House, Vellore Life Challenge.

<u>Women's Fellowship</u>: The Women's Fellowship helps run a day care centre in Kaspa called the Hope Centre, contributes towards feeding the urban poor, supports the higher education of girls, supports the Mahanaim project and contributes towards paying a Bible Woman every month.

<u>Ministerial Fund</u>: This fund is to meet the expenses of guest speakers, travel, food, and accommodation, the Pastor's monthly fixed travel expenses and to pay the salary of any junior or trainee pastor stationed at our church

Bangarupalayam fund: Outreach programme

Nadanur project: Outreach programme

<u>Foster care fund:</u> Contributes towards MBKG Pannai, Arni Boys Home

Publication fund: Used for any publications from the church

<u>Disaster relief fund:</u> This will be used to aid victims of disasters. Most recently it has been used for the Wayanad relief.

<u>Cemetery fund</u>: This is a new fund which has been started with the idea of buying land for a cemetery. This is a long felt need of the church.
