Pastoral Letter

I greet you all in the precious name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

We have entered into another set of months, August and September. August 15th is our Independence Day, the day our country got physical freedom: Our great leaders achieved this through great hardship and sacrifice. But our Lord Jesus achieved spiritual freedom on the mount of Calvary through His sacrificial death on the Cross. It becomes everyone's inheritance when an individual accepts Him as his/her Lord and Saviour. Scripture says, "If the Son therefore shall make you free, you shall be free indeed!" (John: 8:36)

We were very concerned about war erupting in the regions of Israel and Iran. Praise God, it is now under control, thanks to the intervention of global leaders. But we still hear news of tensions prevailing in the state of Manipur, Gaza, Ukraine and in other parts of the world. These places deserve our constant and fervent prayers.

We praise God for the election of the Moderator of the CSI held on 21st July 2025 and we pray that the new Moderator, Rt. Rev. Dr. Reuben Mark will be a good shepherd for the whole of the CSI, and a true follower of the Chief Shepherd, our Lord Jesus Christ. We also praise God for the new Administrative Committee appointed by the CSI Synod under the leadership of our beloved Bishop, the Rt. Rev. Dr. Sharma Nithiyanandham. Let them perform their duties and responsibilities with all diligence and bring normalcy back to our Diocese where the Reformed Church of America and Scudder families toiled and gave their lives for Lord's kingdom.

Confirmation classes are being conducted with the help of our Church leaders who can teach spiritual matters for the edification of the spiritual life of our confirmation candidates. We are thankful to them all.

Let us raise our prayers with the help of Bible verses and rededicate ourselves for the extension and furtherance of His kingdom. Let the following prayers be our own; I request you to start praying fervently. Human life is pictured as fleeting, as

mentioned in 1Peter: 1:24 where it says: 'For, all flesh is like grass and all its glory like the flower of grass. The grass withers and the flower falls".

We praise God for the smooth conduct of the AGM of our Church on 27.07.2025. I hope, you will all agree if I say that our AGM was so fruitful, meaningful and blessed one. Let us continue to be vibrant believers of Christ in the mission and ministries of His great Church and bring glory to His name. Amen.
